

LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT ENGINEER'S REPORT

ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT AND
ORDERING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR 2019-2020 WITHIN THE CITY'S LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICTS

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council, acting as the legislative body for the City's Landscape Maintenance Districts;

1. Hold a public hearing to receive public testimony regarding the proposed Fiscal Year 2019-2020 assessments in the City's Landscape Maintenance Districts, and
2. Adopt a resolution approving the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Consolidated Engineer's Report and ordering the levy and collection of assessments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 within the City's Landscape Maintenance Districts pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972.

On June 4, 2019, City Council is scheduled to adopted a Resolution which initiated proceedings and a Resolution declaring intention to levy assessments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, preliminarily approved the Consolidated Engineer's Report for the thirty six (36) districts, and set a public hearing for June 18, 2019.

The general benefit contribution based on the budgeted expenses for the districts totals \$85,259 and an additional \$139,817 is being proposed to offset the estimated utility overage.

The total Fiscal Year 2019-2020 General Fund contribution is estimated to be approximately \$255,076, which includes \$12,037 for Mandalay Beach/Main (MAD #4)
